The Union County Community Shelter provides emergency shelter, hot meals, case management and rapid rehousing services to our local community.

Last year, 236 adult men and 76 women stayed a combined 10,158 nights in the Shelter, where we served 55,698 meals to 4,011 unique individuals. We assisted 65 families with 158 children in our emergency family housing program and moved 107 households, including 45 families, from homelessness to independent housing.
